Ordinance No. 10:13

**An Ordinance Amending the Code of the Borough of Norwood, Chapter 149,
Establishing the Fees Paid by Limousine and Livery Service Licensees in the Borough**

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to amend chapter 149 of the Code of the Borough of Norwood to establish the annual fee for limousine and livery services as authorized by N.J.S.A 48:16-17, as revised.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 149 of the Code of the Borough of Norwood is amended so that sub-section 149-4(A), titled “Annual Fee and Term of License,” will state the following:

- A. The annual fee for a license for each limousine or livery service is fifty (\$50) dollars plus ten (\$10) dollars for each limousine or livery vehicle that is covered under the required insurance policy. Each application must be accompanied by the full amount of the license fee.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of any inconsistencies.

Section 3: The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining parts of this ordinance will remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon final approval and publication, according to law.
