Matters involving individual privacy: any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational training, social service, medical, health custodial, child protection, rehabilitations, legal defense, welfare, housing relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless, the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing the same be disclosed publicly.
4. Matters relating to collective bargaining agreements or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiations of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.
5. Matters relating to the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property or the investment of public funds, the setting of bank rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.
