MISSION - to Teach/Develop strong Baseball/Softball fundamentals, while enhancing teamwork, sportsmanship, confidence & enthusiasm (FUN).

A Certified Coach Must be Present (no exceptions) **[Both Rutgers Certification & Pitching Machine training]**

- Reservations must be requested with your levels' Commissioner
- Commissioner will provide you with an answer within 1 day
- Commissioner will confirm time & also provide access
- Minimum of 3 players required (teams preferred) for ALL requests
- One hour increments per session
- Requests will be taken 2 weeks in advance – 1st come – 1st serve
- Time Blocks will allocated to each level's Commissioner
- Commissioner to allocate time to each team in his/her group
- Unauthorized Cage usage will result in forfeiture of privileges

COACHES RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **SAFETY IS CRITICAL**
- **Helmets Must be worn**
- **Live Pitching is preferred – using “L” screens**
- Coaches Must Operate Pitching machines under approved situations
- **Only 1 person in Pitching area**
- **Only 1 child in hitting area while machine is operational**
- **Several practice pitches required, before child enters hitting area**
- Proper Bat sizing must be observed
- Children must not enter the Center of the hitting zone
- Soft Toss, Hitting Tee's & Hand Hitting – in 2nd cage
- Coaches must Cleanup, Lock Door, Shut Off Lights, Heaters & Machines
- **NO FOOD or BEVERAGE**
