

MINUTES
MAYOR AND COUNCIL
BOROUGH OF NORWOOD
PUBLIC MEETING
AUGUST 5, 2008

The Public Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood was held at Borough Hall on the above date.

Mayor Barsa called the meeting to order at 8:06 PM.

Mayor Barsa led the Council and those in attendance in a salute to the American flag and asked for a moment of silence.

Mayor Barsa stated:

“Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Public Meeting Law, P.L. 1975, Ch. 231, setting forth the time, date, place and purpose of this Public Meeting through a legal notice published in the Record and Press Journal, filing a copy in the Borough Clerk’s office and posting on the bulletin board.”

Mayor Barsa pointed out the fire exits and requested that all cell phones be turned off or to vibrate.

Public Comment on Agenda Items Only:

It was moved by Mr. Condoleo and seconded by Mr. Scott to open the meeting to the public for comment. All Council Members present voted for the motion.

George Hertzberg, 24 Carter Street, questioned whether the Borough had an ordinance establishing a minimum amount of time that an individual could rent or lease a single or multiple-family home. He voiced concern about the possibility of more transients to the area in light of the present economic climate. The Borough Attorney, Mr. Fede advised that the only ordinance Norwood has regulating the leasing and renting of homes is the prohibition of boarding houses. He further explained that the length of leases is usually between the landlord and tenant. Mayor Barsa asked that he investigate this matter for report at the next Work Session of August 27, 2008.

Greg Salerno, 401 D'Ercole Court, referred to entertainment nights that many surrounding towns hold for their residents and advised that a recent one held by Westwood was sponsored by Commerce Bank. He asked that the Council look into holding such events next year during the summer months.

Dave Elling, 263 Summit Street, referred to the intersection of Broadway and Piermont Road and voiced his opinion that that there should be a stop line on Broadway going onto Piermont Road as motorists on Broadway pull too far into the intersection. Mayor Barsa advised that the Police Department would be asked to look into this matter.

Stuart Bran, 101 Aspen Court, advised he is a board member of the Northwoods Association and has received many complaints that the intersection of Broadway and Piermont Road is poorly lit as the street light is not located near enough to it. Mr. Brizzolara explained that the installation of an additional street light would be recommended by the Police Department, approved by the Mayor and Council and then sent to Orange and Rockland. Of course, this would be an additional expense to the Borough. Mayor Barsa advised that the Police Department would be asked to investigate this matter.

No one else wishing to be heard, a motion to close the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Scott, seconded by Mr. Condoleo and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.

Correspondence:

Mayor Barsa read the following correspondence into the record:

Mayor Barsa informed that anyone wishing a copy of the correspondence could request it from the Borough Clerk.

Consent Agenda:

Mayor Barsa reviewed the items on the Consent Agenda and asked if any Council Member wished to remove an item. No Council Member wishing to be head, Mayor Barsa requested a motion to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the following items:

It was moved by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mr. Condoleo to approve the Consent Agenda. On the roll call vote, all Council Members present voted for the motion.

Committee Reports:

Councilman Brizzolara:

Public Utilities:

Mr. Brizzolara referred to the previous discussion regarding insufficient lighting at the intersection of Broadway and Piermont Road and suggested the current street light be upgraded to better light the area as this would be less expensive than installing an additional lamp post. He also explained that the Borough is entitled to a 2% light upgrade on a yearly basis.

Quiet Zones:

Mr. Brizzolara requested that Closter Mayor Sophie Heymann's letter requesting that Norwood participate in a feasibility study at a cost of \$1,5000 per municipality for alternate measures to wayside horns be an agenda item for discussion at the August 27, 2008 Work Session.

Mr. Brizzolara questioned the reason that the raindate for the fireworks was not used, especially in view of the messy conditions created with them being shot off during the rain. Mayor Barsa explained that once the mortar is dropped into the tubes, the fireworks have to go off. Unfortunately, the fireworks were set up before the sudden storm; and fortunately, there were no injuries.

Councilman Knigin:

Personnel:

Mr. Knigin asked that discussion regarding the replacement of Linda Grove be placed on the August 27, 2008 Work Session agenda.

Council President Scott:

Mr. Scott reported having a conversation with Fr. Leo, the new Pastor of Immaculate Conception Church regarding the Borough's present agreement with them for the use of their fields in return for the DPW cutting the grass and plowing the parking lots. He explained that Fr. Leo demonstrated a willingness to enter into a 25 yr. lease agreement with the Borough to include a "right of first refusal" to purchase the property should it ever be sold. Following a brief discussion, it was the consensus of the Council that this be discussed in Closed Session at the August 27, 2008 Work Session under contract negotiations.

Property/Zoning:

Mr. Scott advised being in receipt of the July Construction Office report. (Attachment "A")

Councilman Guercio:

In the absence of Mr. Guercio, no report was given.

Councilman Rapaport:

In the absence of Mr. Rapaport, no report was given.

Councilman Condoleo:

Fire Department:

Mr. Condoleo read the Fire Department's June Report (Attachment "B"). Mr. Condoleo reported giving authorization to the Fire Chief to submit a requisition for the purchase of a new thermal imaging camera since it was included in the capital budget and the present one cannot be repaired.

Finance:

Mr. Condoleo explained that the Borough is waiting to hear from the County what the tax rate would be and that tax bills would probably not be sent out until August 15, 2008. Taxes would be due 25 days after the mailing date. Mr. Condoleo further explained that only those items essential to the operation of the Borough would be paid, i.e. utilities, salaries, insurances. Both Norwood Public and the Regional High School have been notified and do not have an issue with late payment. As taxes are received, more bills will be paid.

General Public Comment:

It was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Scott to open the meeting to the public for comment. All Council Members present voted for the motion.

George Hertzberg, 24 Carter Street, referred to the Fourth of July fireworks and advised that for those who stayed, it was spectacular seeing them through the cloud caused by the dampness.

No other member of the public wishing to be heard, a motion to close the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Brizzolara, seconded by Mr. Knigin and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.

At 8:32 PM, it was moved by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mr. Knigin to adjourn. All Council Members present voted in favor of the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
