

BOROUGH OF NORWOOD
MAYOR AND COUNCIL MINUTES
PUBLIC MEETING, JUNE 3, 2009

The Public Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood was held at Borough Hall on the above date.

Mayor Barsa called the meeting to order at 8:05 PM and led those in attendance in a salute to the American Flag and asked for a moment of silence.

Mayor Barsa stated:

“Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Public Meeting Law, P.L. 1975, Ch. 231, setting forth the time, date, place and purpose of this Public Meeting through a legal notice published in the Record and Press Journal, filing a copy in the Borough Clerk’s office and posting on the bulletin board.”

Mayor Barsa pointed out the fire exits and requested that all cell phones be turned off or to vibrate.

Public Comment on Agenda Items Only:

It was moved by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mr. Condoleo to open the meeting to the public for comment. All Council Members present voted for the motion. There being no member of the public wishing to be heard, a motion to close the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Scott, seconded by Mr. Rapaport and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.

Correspondence:

Mayor Barsa read the following correspondence into the record:

1. Fire Chief's April Report to Governor Corzine regarding Valley and Englewood Hospitals proposal to purchase the former Pascack Valley Hospital and urging the Governor to permit the Hospital to reopen
2. A letter from Garden State Chapter of the Myasthenia Gravis Foundation, Inc requesting assistance in proclaiming June as Myasthenia Gravis awareness month
3. A letter from Scleroderma Foundation, Tri-State Inc. Chapter requesting the Mayor to sign a proclamation on behalf of the Borough of Norwood declaring June, 2009 as "Scleroderma Awareness Month"

Mayor Barsa informed that anyone wishing a copy of the correspondence could request it from the Borough Clerk.

Mayor Barsa reviewed the items on the Consent Agenda and asked if any Council Member wished to remove an item. No Council Member wishing to be heard, Mayor Barsa requested a motion to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the following items:

It was moved by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mrs. Orecchio to approve the Consent Agenda. On the roll call vote, all Council Members present voted for the motion.

Public Hearing of Ordinance 09:04:

Mayor Barsa stated he had before him an ordinance for Council action entitled:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE TO FIX SALARIES, WAGES, AND COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN OFFICIALS, OFFICERS, AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF NORWOOD, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY” TO PROVIDE FOR AND DETERMINE THE RATE AND METHOD OF COMPENSATION FOR CLASS II SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2009

It was moved by Mr. Rapaport and seconded by Mr. Scott to open the meeting to the public regarding Ordinance 09:04.

Mr. Murray Bass, Piermont Road requested clarification on the distinction of a Class II Special Police Officer. Mr. Rapaport informed that a Class II Special has arrest powers and may carry a weapon. Mr. Bottinelli, Borough Attorney clarified that a Class II Officer may only carry a weapon while on duty within the borough boundaries.

Ms. Lisa Kurtz, D’Ercole Court wanted to know if it is necessary for a Special Police Officer to carry a weapon. It was explained that this particular officer put himself through the police academy and will be helpful when the Borough is short staffed. Mr. Bottinelli explained the difference between a Class I and Class II SLEO.

There being no other member of the public wishing to be heard, it was moved by Mrs. Orecchio and seconded by Mr. Rapaport to close the meeting to the public. A motion to adopt Ordinance 09:04 was made by Mr. Rapaport and seconded by Mr. Condoleo. On the roll call vote:

Mayor Barsa stated he had before him an ordinance for Council action entitled:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED
“AN ORDINANCE TO FIX SALARIES, WAGES, AND COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN OFFICIALS, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF NORWOOD, COUNTY OF BERGEN, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY” AND SETTING FORTH THE METHOD OF PAYING SALARIES AND ANY OTHER ORDINANCES AMENDING SAID ORDINANCE

It was moved by Mr. Condoleo and seconded by Mr. Rapaport to open the meeting to the public regarding Ordinance 09:05. There being no member of the public wishing to be heard, it was moved by Mr. Rapaport and seconded by Mrs. Orecchio to close the meeting to the public. A motion to adopt Ordinance 09:05 was made by Mr. Rapaport and seconded by Mr. Condoleo. On the roll call vote:

Nays: None
Absent: Brizzolara

There being five (5) ayes and no nays, Ordinance 09:05 was approved. Mayor Barsa announced that the ordinance was finally adopted and will take effect upon publication in the Press Journal and after a twenty-day waiting period.

Committee Reports:

Mayor Barsa:

Mayor Barsa referenced a letter received from Mrs. Barbara Dill, Norwood Cub Scout Pack 120 requesting permission to use Kennedy Field to build Estes Model Rockets and launch them. Mayor Barsa invited Mrs. Ruth Falkenstern, Borough Risk Manager to address the request with the Council. Mrs. Falkenstern reviewed the requirements and concerns expressed by the Joint Insurance Fund regarding the Cub Scout's request. It was the consensus of the Council to permit Pack 120 to build and launch the rockets if all of the conditions and concerns of the JIF are met.

Councilman Brizzolara:

In the absence of Mr. Brizzolara no report was given.

Councilwoman Orecchio:

Emergency Medical Services: Mrs. Orecchio informed that the vehicle EMS obtained from the Police Department will be lettered to show that it is a Norwood vehicle. The EMS held a garage sale this past weekend as a fund raiser and it was successful.

Board of Education: Mrs. Orecchio announced that Dr. Rose, Superintendent is retiring on June 30 after 29 years of service to Norwood Public School. Mrs. Orecchio informed that Norwood Public School will receive \$176,000 in stimulus money that will be used for special education programs.

Council President Scott:

Construction Department: Mr. Scott read the Building Department Monthly Report (Attachment "A"). He informed that revenues continue to be down and only \$4,452 was collected in fees.

Board of Health: Mr. Scott informed that the Board of Health will be purchasing Child Identification Kits to be sold on Norwood Day. These kits hold DNA samples taken by parents and kept in the refrigerator. Councilman Rapaport offered to donate \$150 towards the purchase of the kits on behalf of him and his wife. Councilman Scott also offered to donate \$150.

Councilman Nicolai:

Department of Public Works: Mr. Nicolai informed that a walk through was conducted at the Kennedy Park War Memorial prior to releasing payment to Let it Grow. One of the items on the punch list is the Service Star that is on back order. Mr. Nicolai informed that he is reviewing department procedures and getting acquainted with the staff.

Councilman Rapaport:

Police Department: Mr. Rapaport read the Police Department's monthly report (Attachment "B").

Personnel: The Borough is presently in negotiations with the DPW and PBA. Mr. Rapaport requested a status report on the ordinance to authorize background checks of recreation personnel and coaches. Mr. Nicolai informed that he is the new liaison to Recreation and that he supports instituting background checks. Mrs. Falkenstern, Risk Manager requested who receives the reports. She was informed that the report is sent to the Chief of Police.

Councilman Condoleo:

Fire Department: Mr. Condoleo read the Fire Department Monthly Report for April (Attachment "C"). Mr. Condoleo informed that the 3rd responder truck, the pumper has broken down and was sent out for repairs.

Historic Preservation Committee: The Norwood Historic Preservation Committee continues to work on delineating the Haring Cemetery and is in the process of obtaining landscape designs.

Finance Committee: Mr. Condoleo informed that the Committee met with the State regarding the 2009 Budget and the outcome of the meeting was for the Mayor and Council to review the budget and look for areas that could be trimmed.

Mayor Barsa:

DPW: Mayor Barsa commended the DPW for getting the Borough ready for Memorial Day. It was requested that the schedule for Trackside Park be reviewed to determine a date the park can be closed for reseeding.

Recreation: Mayor Barsa commended Mr. Plescia for his efforts in raising all of the funds for the July Fourth Fireworks from private donations.

General Public Comment:

It was moved by Mrs. Orecchio and seconded by Mr. Scott to open the meeting to the public for comment. All Council Members present voted for the motion.






Summons Productivity 5 Year Comparison





Number of Accidents 3 Year Comparison




Incident Frequency by Month (Using DATE RECD)










Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 164 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)



By Day of Week




Weekday vs Weekend





Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 110 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)




