

Borough of Norwood  
Special/Executive Session  
June 22, 2011

11:129 Authorizing execution of an agreement between the Borough of Norwood and Police Chief Jeffrey L. Krapels for the years 2009 through 2013

The motion was made by Mr. Rapaport, seconded by Mrs. Orecchio and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.

Mr. Rapaport noted that the agreement for Chief Krapels is exactly the same as the PBA agreement.
