

**BOROUGH OF NORWOOD
MAYOR AND COUNCIL MINUTES
PUBLIC MEETING
MAY 9, 2012**

The Public Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood was held at Borough Hall on the above date.

Mayor Barsa called the meeting to order at 8:15 PM and led those in attendance in a salute to the American Flag and asked for a moment of silence.

Livingston Street Beautification:






Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 82 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)

Weekday vs Weekend








Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 130 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
