

**BOROUGH OF NORWOOD  
MAYOR AND COUNCIL MINUTES  
PUBLIC MEETING  
March 13, 2013**

The Public Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood was held at Borough Hall on the above date.

Mayor Barsa called the meeting to order at 8:00 PM and led those in attendance in a salute to the American Flag and asked for a moment of silence.

Mayor Barsa stated:

“Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Public Meeting Law, P.L. 1975, Ch. 231, setting forth the time, date, place and purpose of this Public Meeting through a legal notice published in the Record, filing a copy in the Borough Clerk’s office and posting on the bulletin board.”

Mayor Barsa pointed out the fire exits and requested that all cell phones be turned off or to vibrate.

**General Public Comment:**

It was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mrs. Orecchio to open the meeting to the public for comment. All Council Members present voted for the motion.

There being no member of the public wishing to be heard, a motion to close the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Brizzolara, seconded by Mr. Scott and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.

**Introduction of Ordinance 13:02 entitled:**

CALENDAR YEAR 2013 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL  
BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK  
(N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14)

Mayor Barsa asked for a motion to introduce Ordinance 13:02. The motion was made by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mrs. Orecchio. On the roll call vote:

Ayes: Brizzolara, Scott, Orecchio, Rapaport and Ascolese  
Nays: None  
Absent: Condoleo

There being five (5) ayes and no nays ordinance 13:02 was introduced. Mayor Barsa announced that the Public Hearing on this ordinance would be April 24, 2013 at 7:00 PM.

**Approval of Resolution 13:58 Providing for Self Examination of the 2013 Municipal Budget**

Motion to approve Resolution 13:58 was made by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Scott with all Council Members present voting in the affirmative.

At this time, Mayor Barsa commended the Auditor, Steven Wielkocz and the Chief Financial Officer, Kunjesh Trivedi for their collaboration with Lorraine McMackin, Administrator/Clerk in preparing the Budget. He also thanked the members of the Finance Committee for their input.

The Borough Auditor, Steven Wielkocz explained to the governing body and public that the 2013 Budget appropriations increased a little over \$72,000 from the previous year. Much of this increase was contributed to contract obligations for employees, a \$41,000 increase in BCUA fees and \$27,000 in health benefit costs. He further explained that the operating budgets of all departments decreased by \$70,000 from the previous year.

Mr. Wielkocz advised that the tax levy is over the CAP by \$48,000 which represents a tax increase of 2% for the average home assessed at \$550,000 or a \$65.64 increase in the municipal tax rate. He voiced his opinion that this budget reflects the Borough as financially stable with the surplus being rebuilt to a \$1M plus amount.

Motion to introduce the 2013 Municipal Budget was made by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Rapaport. On the roll call vote:

There being five (5) ayes and no nays the 2013 Municipal Budget was introduced. Mayor Barsa announced that the Public Hearing on the Budget would be held on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 at 7:00 PM.

It was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mrs. Orecchio to approve the Consent Agenda. On the roll call vote, all Council Members present voted for the motion.

**Introduction of Ordinance 13:03:**

Mayor Barsa asked for a motion to introduce Ordinance 13:03,

“AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A NEW CHAPTER 181 OF THE CODE THE BOROUGH OF NORWOOD REGULATING RENTAL PROPERTY”

The motion was made by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Rapaport. On the question, Mr. Scott advised of his understanding that there is no definition or Borough ordinance relating to mother/daughter dwellings and voiced his opinion that there is a need for a legal definition for this type residence. Following a brief discussion, the Borough Attorney advised that this ordinance is not a zoning ordinance but a licensing ordinance for two-family dwellings. He further explained that the definition of “family” has been expanded to include non-related individuals living as a family. On roll call vote of the motion, all Council Members present voted in the affirmative.

**Committee Reports:**

**Councilman Brizzolara:**

Personnel Committee Report:

Mr. Brizzolara advised he would defer to Mr. Ascolese to report on the Department of Public Works. He commended the Department Heads and Borough Professionals in preparing the 2013 Municipal Budget.

**Councilman Scott**

Library:

Mr. Scott reported that bids were received for the library renovation and that the lowest bid was approximately \$475,000 for the base bid and Alternate No. 1.

He advised that the Library Board of Trustees met on Monday and that the Mayor and Council would be receiving a letter from them stating that they would not proceed with the installation of the generator as it was learned that a separate gas line would be needed from the street.

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Construction Office:

Mr. Scott referred to the Fee Log Report for February, Attachment "A".

**Councilwoman Orecchio**

Norwood EMS:

Mrs. Orecchio advised she had nothing to report.

Norwood Public School:

Mrs. Orecchio reported that the Norwood Board of Education meets next week.

Northern Valley Regional High School:

Mrs. Orecchio reported attending a meeting on behalf of the Mayor regarding the proposal to refurbish the fields and resurface the tennis courts and tracks at both the Northern Valley Regional High School campuses. The cost for both would be approximately \$5M to be bonded over a 15-year period. This would translate to a \$25.36 annual increase for a Norwood home assessed at \$549,000.00. The Board of Education will present this proposal to the public as a referendum.

Municipal Court:

Mr. Rapaport read the Court's Annual report into the record, Attachment "B".

Norwood Police Department:

Mr. Rapaport referenced the Chief's Monthly Report for February Attachment "C".

Planning Board:

No report at this time.

**Councilman Condoleo:**

Fire Department:

In the absence of Mr. Condoleo no report was given.

Finance:

In the absence of Mr. Condoleo no report was given.

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**Councilman Ascolese:**

Board of Health:

Mr. Ascolese referred to the Board's monthly report from its March 4, 2013 meeting, Attachment "D".

Department of Public Works:

Mr. Ascolese noted that the representatives from Jersey Professional Services are on site as of last week. He voiced his opinion that the decision to hire this firm was a good one as their observations have evolved into making recommendations regarding equipment and manpower. He also referred to the Department's monthly report for February, Attachment "E".

**Closed Session:**

It was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Rapaport to approve Resolution 13:73 authorizing the governing body to go into closed session for the purpose of discussing matters relating to collective bargaining units and professional services and employment. All Council Members present voted in favor of the motion.

At 8:30 PM, Mayor Barsa adjourned the public portion of the meeting to proceed into Closed Session.

Mayor Barsa reconvened the meeting at 9:03 PM.

Motion was made by Mr. Rapaport authorizing a Professional Services Contract with Louis N. Rainone, Esq. as Borough Labor Attorney for the year 2013 (Resolution 13:74). The motion was second by Mr. Ascolese and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.

Motion was made by Mr. Rapaport authorizing Chief Krapels to advertise for a Police Officer to replace Officer Bourke whose resignation becomes effective March 26, 2013. The motion was seconded by Mr. Scott with all Council Members present voting aye.

Motion was made by Mr. Brizzolara appointing Mimi Marinkovic as an Administrative Assistant for the Administrator's Clerk's Office for fifteen hours per week at a salary of \$15 per hour beginning Monday, March 18, 2013 (Resolution 13:75). The motion was seconded by Mr. Scott and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.

Motion to open the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Brizzolara, seconded by Mr. Rapaport and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present. Seeing and hearing no one, motion to close the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Rapaport. All Council Members present voted in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mrs. Orecchio to adjourn. All Council Members present voted in favor of the motion and the meeting was adjourned. Meeting adjourned at 9:40 PM.


**Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 113 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)**

**Weekday vs Weekend**








**Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 92 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)**

The Board of Health is currently discussing options for our 2013 flu clinic which may include providing the clinic through CVS of Closter.


Discussion continued regarding health topics for a monthly article for the Northern Valley Press.
