Mr. Ascolese referred to the DPW monthly report (Attachment "D").






Summons Productivity 5 Year Comparison





Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 160 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)










Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 80 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)

August Monthly Report

All first of the month inspections and documentations have been completed.

Pump station maintenance and sewer main trouble areas only can be maintained at this time. Manpower and vacation time off hinders complete waste water service operation along with storm water management.

Piermont road pump station force main fractured in the center of Piermont road and was soon repaired by Tobar Excavating without any environmental concerns. I can't thank Tom Locovare enough, for he has always been there in our time of need.

Street sweeping continues

A storm water basin at 18 Garnett, basin collapsed and was repaired.

The new street sweeper has arrived! Training for all personnel was held at Old Tappan. Once the two way radio and graphics (shared services Borough of Old Tappan and Norwood) are completed you will be seeing this equipment cleaning up our town.

Chipping roadside brush continues to be an everyday job task with no end in sight. By the end of the route we must start over again, we are now chipping biweekly. I receive many complaints but I do explain this operation is not a Monday thru Friday service and will be collected as soon as possible.

Livingston street scape maintenance continues, litter pick up, garbage pickup, watering trees and flowers, weeding, repairs etc. In preparation for fall, new baskets and fall flowers have been ordered.

At Kennedy Park the football and soccer fields have been marked out and painted. The baseball fields are being reworked – edged, seeded, tilled, groomed for next year's season.

Grass cutting/edging at all Borough locations parks and grounds continue. Step 3 fertilizing at Kennedy Park, Trackside field and the public school has been done. All weed spraying and flower bed maintenance has been achieved including trimming all the shrubs.

The monument fountain was cleaned, painted and refilled.

All building maintenance/cleaning continue.

Vehicle and equipment maintenance continue including vehicle washing.

Two mason dump trucks have been delivered and were sent out for lettering, lights and radios. We are specking out plow and coupler designs for these new trucks including spot chains. The Mack trucks are almost complete, we will be receiving them the end of next month.

At this time we are now getting the salt spreaders and leaf equipment ready for the upcoming seasons.

Many dangerous trees were removed with the help from O&R tree crew at John St, Kensington Ave west, Somerset Ave, Rockland Ave, and Broadway and Walnut St. Also a letter was sent out to Bergen County to have a hazardous tree removed at 1125 Blanch Avenue.

Overgrown brush and dirt erosion was removed on the south side of Rockland Ave to paint a sidewalk stripe from Walnut St. to the Chodae church at Veterans Drive.

Repainting traffic lines will continue until school reopens.

All E waste was picked up this month. Most E waste was dropped off at the DPW yard by residents totaling 40 cu yard's.

Lightning detection signage has been installed at all Kennedy Park locations, including the pond area.

This quarter one finger injury was reported, but no medical or time was lost. This was not a ppe issue just carelessness.
