

**BOROUGH OF NORWOOD
MAYOR AND COUNCIL MINUTES
PUBLIC MEETING
MAY 13, 2015**

The Public Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood was held at Borough Hall on the above date.

Mayor Barsa called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and led those in attendance in a salute to the American Flag and asked for a moment of silence in remembrance of longtime resident and Borough Engineer, Mr. Joseph Neglia.

Councilman Brizzolara

Fire Department:

Mr. Brizzolara announced that the Fire Department held a drill at Fox Hill Manor on Sunday. Six other fire companies from surrounding towns were involved in the drill.

Councilman Marino

Board of Health:

Mr. Marino read the Board of Health Report for the month of March (Attachment "A"). He informed that the Board of Health is reviewing the Food Handler's Ordinance for possible revisions.

Councilwoman Orecchio

EMS:

Mrs. Orecchio reported being in receipt of the monthly report for February, Attachment "B".

Board of Education:

Mrs. Orecchio said she was disappointed in the attendance at the meeting regarding how the schools are dealing with drugs and alcohol. She informed that there is a \$125,000 grant available to help schools hire someone to look into different programs and how best to integrate them into the curriculum. On the local level towns can create opportunities for the police department to interact more with the students as well as local government passing stricter ordinances against underage drinking.

Mr. Ascolese submitted the Road Department's monthly report for the record, Attachment "C". He also thanked Mr. Rapaport for training the department on the proper way to clean the floors.

Councilman Rapaport:

Planning Board:

Mr. Rapaport reported that the major subdivision application for the Jones' property was carried for one month and will be heard later in June. He said that the Planning Board is standing firm with some changes they want to see in the plan. He also said that the Board has not yet begun meeting to address the Master Plan.

Police Department:

Mr. Rapaport submitted the Police Department March report Attachment "D". Mr. Rapaport commended the department for the excellent job they did in handling the crowds during the Grand Opening of Callahan's.

General Public Comment:

It was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Rapaport to open the meeting to the public for comment. All Council Members present voted for the motion. There being no member of the public wishing to be heard, a motion to close the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Brizzolara, seconded by Mr. Ascolese and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.

Closed Session:

It was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Ascolese to approve Resolution 15:106 authorizing the governing body to convene into closed session to discuss the police personnel. On the roll call vote all council members present voted for the motion.

In the month of April there was one ambulance corps function. The only function was the monthly business meeting which we discussed new and old business for the month of April.

Please find the April call report for Norwood EMS enclosed. Norwood EMS responded to 38 Calls in the month of April. A breakdown of call types/locations is below.

In the month of April Norwood EMS personnel logged 2140 hours on calls and 16 hours on drills/monthly meeting.

April Monthly Report 2015

The winter that keeps on giving.

It's not bad enough that we are doing fall cleanups in the spring time, but also trying to save our roadways and infrastructure by repairing storm drains and pot holes. We spent 4 days preparing and repairing Oak St. with 40 tons of material.

We have a long way to go with road repairs and will attend to these issues the best we can. We ask that our residents be patient.

Spring time

April has brought us a tremendous work load. We are currently mowing, raking and lining baseball fields per daily schedules. The soccer field at trackside has been marked out and painted. We have placed extra garbage receptacles for litter at these locations. These stops have been added to our twice weekly pickup. All residents are removing yard debris and branches at this time of the year which requires every day roadside chipping with two men for the next several weeks in order to keep up with demand.

The new sweeper is out and will take around 2 weeks to complete with one operator.

Grass cutting throughout the community takes 4 days with two men

Building cleaning continues each day with one man.

Then comes the extras.

Two hazardous trees this month were removed and the rest must wait.

Water meter installs/irrigation startups plus adjustments

Daily cleaning of Kennedy Field bathrooms including plumbing repairs to fix broken pipes and leaks.

We are preparing to install new pond fountains

Moving everything out of DPW yard to prepare for building construction/

Washing and maintaining trucks and equipment.

Checking sewer problems areas and pump stations including maintenance

Planting trees on Livingston Street

Installing banners on Livingston Street

We have two building that must be painted due to vending machine removal and left an ugly spot and two new dugouts that must be painted also.

The bocce courts have been resurfaced and maintained to playable conditions

Cleaning the batting cage weekly continues

Electronic day pickup continues every 3rd Wednesday of the month

Weekly flower bed maintenance at all buildings, parks and grounds.

After we did an inspection in the children's park we found it necessary to replace all the swings and chain.

Truck Salt Spreaders have been removed, cleaned and greased and relocated to Norwood Fire Dept.

The two damaged pickup trucks have been restored and are back in service.

A gigantic oak tree had fallen across the Dwarskill creek at the Norwood-Closter border from Hurricane Sandy. A Closter resident was concerned for children's safety for they have been playing on and crossing over the creek on it. Closter DPW was in agreement with this hazard and assisted us with removing the tree.

The Wi-Fi was installed by our department. One unit was placed at the batting cage and the other unit was placed at our building. We are now awaiting the final install for the swipe card entry system.

Building Maintenance

Allen Rapport was extremely helpful by giving us a hands on training class in the proper use of chemicals, tools and equipment needed to clean building floors.

My department was very impressed by how helpful this was and we thank him for his teaching experience.

Now that we are cleaning correctly, maybe we can find more time to do so because this needs to be done more frequently. Thank you Allen, we all learned a lot.

We had many unannounced visits from the DEP. First was the leaf compost facility inspection. Next was for storm water management records and visual inspections and last was for the UST (underground storage tank) inspection of our floor drain oil interceptor and leak detection equipment.

All were properly maintained and passed inspection

All first of the month inspection and documentations have been completed.

Comments from the Superintendent:

As requested in the past, a streets & roads foreman would be a tremendous help to me so that I may have more time to attend to my Superintendent duties.

Now that Jim Smith has retired, it is imperative to replace him as soon as possible. Employee vacation time off has begun. As you should know it is becoming more difficult to keep up with the general maintenance with the existing staff. I can't stress this enough that I need help. Please hire immediately because we are falling behind on daily duties.

We are in the process of ordering capital equipment such as the leaf machine and the salt spreader for the hook lift so that it will arrive in time to take care of Norwood's needs.







Weekday vs Weekend








Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 80 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
