

**BOROUGH OF NORWOOD
MAYOR AND COUNCIL MINUTES
PUBLIC MEETING
OCTOBER 14, 2015**

The Public Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood was held at Borough Hall on the above date.

Mayor Barsa called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM and led those in attendance in a salute to the American Flag and asked for a moment of silence.

Mayor Barsa stated:

“Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Public Meeting Law, P.L. 1975, Ch. 231, setting forth the time, date, place and purpose of this Public Meeting through a legal notice published in the Record and Star Ledger, filing a copy in the Borough Clerk’s office and posting on the bulletin board.”

Mayor Barsa pointed out the fire exits and requested that all cell phones be turned off or to vibrate.

Presentations:

Cho Dae Presbyterian Church presented checks to Norwood EMS and Fire Department as well as presenting a trophy to the Borough for beating the Borough of Northvale in the recently held Charity Golf Outing.

Mayor Barsa presented plaques to the Woman’s Club of Norwood/Northvale and Norwood Fire Co. No. 1 for their contributions to Norwood Day.

Mayor Barsa presented Certificates to Norwood Raider’s Cheerleaders for their participation in Norwood Day.

Chief Krapels along with Mayor Barsa and Councilman Rapaport presented retiring Police Officer Tom Russo with a plaque to commemorate his service to the Borough of Norwood.

After the presentations a five minute recess was taken.

General Public Comment:

It was moved by Mrs. Orecchio and seconded by Mr. Scott to open the meeting to the public for comment. All Council Members present voted for the motion.

Ms. Sue Park, 466 Livingston Street informed the governing body that numerous trucks and buses are using the entrance on Jay Street to cut through and beat the light on Livingston Street. She also said that cars are parking in her lot that are not tenants in her building. Mayor Barsa said that he would visit the property in the morning and take the necessary measures to make sure that the entrance is closed and will instruct the DPW to install 2 hour parking limit signs at the parking spaces that are owned by the Borough. He also said that a letter will be sent to the bus company to let them know that the entrance is not a means of egress. The Borough will look into instituting an ordinance to prohibit parking on private property.

Mrs. Park also complained about containers that were left on Jay Street from the Ippolito building. Mayor Barsa said he would also address that issue.

There being no other member of the public wishing to be heard, a motion to close the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Scott, seconded by Mrs. Orecchio and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.

Holiday Parade:

Mr. Marino reported that the Northern Valley High School and Paramus Catholic High School bands will not be participating in the holiday parade. He has been in contact with the County Police Band to see if they would participate. He said there would be a fee involved if the County were to participate. In regards to the parade, Mr. Joel Rubin will be organizing the children to sing traditional Hebrew songs and has requested a Menorah be placed alongside the tree at the Town Center.

Environmental Commission:

Mr. Paul Haberman is working on creating a shade tree ordinance.

Board of Health:

Mr. Marino read the Board of Health Report for September, see Attachment "A".

Councilwoman Orecchio

EMS:

Mrs. Orecchio reported being in receipt of the monthly report for September, see Attachment "B".

Board of Education:

Mrs. Orecchio announced that the high school is looking into a Referendum for January or March that could be in the neighborhood of 13M.

Councilman Ascolese:

Department of Public Works:

Mr. Ascolese submitted the Road Department's monthly report for the record, Attachment "C". He announced that the final day for grass pick up by Miele Sanitation will be Monday, November 2, 2015 after that grass may be mixed in with the leaves and placed curbside.

Councilman Rapaport:

Police Department:

Mr. Rapaport referenced the Police Department's Monthly Report, Attachment "D". Mr. Rapaport reported on an accident that occurred over the weekend that took out the traffic light at the intersection of Livingston Street and Blanch Avenue. There was extensive damage and the light is still out.

Planning Board:

Mr. Rapaport reported that the Planning Board did not meet during the month of September and he is hopeful that they will meet in November to work on the Master Plan.

Councilman Scott:

Mr. Scott questioned why Summit Street had not been restriped after the recent micro-paving. He was informed that the Chief of Police had requested that the road not be stripped for safety reasons. Mr. Scott asked that this issue be revisited.

Library:

Mr. Scott informed that the new Library Director, Ms. Maureen Cuschieri is a Norwood Resident.

Building Department:

Mr. Scott asked that the Construction Report for the month of September, attachment "E" be placed into the record.

Seniors:

Mr. Scott informed that the Norwood Senior Citizen Club is the most active in the area.

Mayor Barsa:

Mayor Barsa informed that Norwood Runners Club has reached their maximum sign up of 50 children. A card reader has been installed at the entrance to the batting cage. All coaches will receive a swipe card to use for accessing the batting cage. He said that the card reader and cameras that were installed last year with help the Borough further monitor the batting cage usage and help prevent children from entering unattended. Councilman Ascolese commended the new children's running club and said that he hopes in the future it will help the participation in the 5K Run. He went on to say that this

September Monthly Report

Autumn begins.

I'm glad to report that for the first time road paving was completed during the summer months insuring proper compaction for longer lasting roadways. Micro paving was also completed although misunderstood for hot pavement this application worked out very well to seal and protect our degraded streets.

The Knickerbocker field fence project is done. We painted the dugouts and are now beginning field improvements for a quality playing baseball field.

Our Public Works garage is near completion. All utilities gas, water and electric have been connected. Insulation, garage doors, ventilation and lights have also been completed. Our parking lot has been compromised from hundreds of feet of utility trenches and drainage piping. We placed a temporary patch, but they will need to be properly resurfaced ASAP.

We helped out with the Boy Scouts seating area project at the library. Everyone is pleased on how it turned out.

Maintenance on Livingston St. with fall tree trimming is complete and we have changed out the summer flowers for fall mums.

Contracted routine maintenance for the HVAC roof units at the Borough Hall found holes in the heat exchangers that will cause carbon monoxide poisoning in the building. The cost of repairs is around \$8,000 and I feel it would be a good idea to install CO detectors in all offices. I will find out the cost to get this done.

Ongoing preparation for leaf season continues. We are repairing and rebuilding our old leaf machines to get ready for 2015 leaf season. We finally were able to order the new leaf machine this month, but we won't see it until January. These machines take months to build and that's why we needed to order months ago.

Building maintenance continues. All floors need to be done, but we just don't have the time. I was hoping for some rainy days, but we haven't had any of those either. This would be a good job for a third part time employee.

Storm water management has been consuming many hours. The men are out there repairing dilapidated catch basins. We have repaired six basins with many more on the list. Sweeping streets each month is also a DEP requirement including staff training. This has been completed.

O&R has helped us once again working together to remove four more trees that died due to drought conditions.

Roadside brush pickup continues bi-weekly including stump and log pickup.

Pump station maintenance is kept well. Sewer maintenance is difficult due to many miles of pipe. We are trying to keep up with trouble areas, but not enough side streets. The resident at 105 Dyer Court had wastewater enter their home due to a backup. We have followed protocol and I have added this to our trouble list.

Weekly grass cutting, edging, and weeding continue to our parks and grounds.

All garbage and litter pickup continues each week.

We are painting the football field and four soccer fields each week.

I also prepared the men for leaf pickup and snowplowing with a JIF safety course in our Borough Hall.

All first of the month inspections and documentations were completed this month.

E-waste pickup was completed

Senior pickup and drop offs have been on the rise. We drive them to their doctors appointments, food shopping and to the senior meetings and back home.

This has been affecting daily operations. Any update on hiring a driver for the senior van will be greatly appreciated.

Town Day was a great success thanks to everyone's involvement. The adults enjoyed the food and music and the children were having fun with everything. Looking forward to next year's Town Day.







Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 165 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)










Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 85 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
