

**MINUTES
MAYOR AND COUNCIL
BOROUGH OF NORWOOD
PUBLIC MEETING
February 6, 2007**

The Public Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood was held at Borough Hall on the above date.

Mayor Barsa called the meeting to order at 8:00 PM.

Mayor Barsa led the Council and those in attendance in a salute to the American flag and asked for a moment of silence.

Mayor Barsa stated:

“ Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Public Meeting Law, P.L. 1975, Ch. 231, setting forth the time, date, place and purpose of this Public Meeting through a legal notice published in the Press Journal on January 11, 2007, filing a copy in the Borough Clerk’s office and posting on the bulletin board.”

A motion to open the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Councilman Scott with all Council Members present voting in favor of the motion.

Since no member of the public wished to be heard, it was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Scott to close the meeting to the public with all Council Members present voting in favor of the motion.

Bid Opening for the 1988 100 GPM 3D Rescue Pumper:

The Borough Clerk announced that only one bid had been received and that was from Triangle Fire Department, Whitney Point, NY for \$31,000.00. It was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mrs. Senatore that the Borough accept the bid of \$31,000.00 for the purchase of this fire truck. All Council Members present voted in favor of the motion. The Borough Attorney was instructed to prepare a resolution memorializing the Council’s decision.

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Consent Agenda:

Mayor Barsa reviewed the items on the Consent Agenda and asked if any Council Member wished to remove an item. No Council Member wishing to be heard, Mayor Barsa asked for a motion to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the following items:

- Resolution 07:48 Authorizing the issuance of Raffle Licenses 07:03 and 07:04 to Closter PTO
- Resolution 07:49 Authorizing a street opening permit (No.07:01) to PSEG for 2 Meadow Lane
- Resolution 07:50 Authorizing 2006 Budget Appropriation Reserves transfer in the amount of \$6,000.00
- Resolution 07:51 Authorizing Mr. Andrew Fede, Borough Attorney to take the necessary steps for the Borough to acquire the property known as the Haring Cemetery at a fee not to exceed \$3,500.00

It was moved by Mr. Guercio and seconded by Mrs. Senatore to introduce this ordinance on its first hearing. All Council Members present voted in favor of the motion. Mayor Barsa informed that the public hearing on this ordinance would be held on March 6, 2007.

Mr. Scott offered a motion to open the meeting to the public. The motion was seconded by Mr. Brizzolara with all Council Members present voting in favor of the motion. No one wishing to be heard, it was moved by Mr. Scott and seconded by Ms. Senatore to close the meeting to the public. All Council Members present voted in favor of the motion.

Public Hearing of Ordinance 07:02

Mayor Barsa announced that the public hearing on this ordinance will take place this evening, but due to misprint in the introduction advertisement, the ordinance cannot be voted on for adoption. The ordinance will again be heard on March 6, 2007.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 174 OF THE CODE OF
THE BOROUGH OF NORWOOD TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM
FINES AND PENALTIES THAT MAY BE IMPOSED FOR
VIOLATIONS OF BOROUGH ORDINANCES

Mr. Brizzolara offered a motion to open the meeting to the public. The motion was seconded by Mr. Guercio with all Council Members present voting in favor of the motion. No one wishing to be heard, it was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded Mr. Scott to close the meeting to the public. All Council Members present voted in favor of the motion.

Public Hearing of Ordinance 07:03

Mayor Barsa announced that the public hearing on this ordinance will take place this evening, but due to misprint in the introduction advertisement, the ordinance cannot be voted on for adoption. The ordinance will again be heard on March 6, 2007.

Public Hearing on Ordinance 07:03 Continued:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 233 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NORWOOD TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM FINES AND PENALTIES THAT MAY BE IMPOSED FOR VIOLATIONS OF BOROUGH ZONING AND LAND USE ORDINANCES

Ms. Senatore made a motion to table this ordinance and requested that the Council meet with the Planning Board to address their concerns with illegal two family dwellings. Mrs. Senatore is concerned with how the Borough is going to handle those homes that have been converted into two family dwellings. Mr. Guercio seconded the motion and all of the Council Members present voted in favor of the motion. The Clerk was instructed to contact the Planning Board and arrange for a joint meeting to be held on Wednesday, February 28, 2007 at 8:00 p.m.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Councilman Brizzolara:

Public Utilities: Mr. Brizzolara reminded that Friday is bulk pick-up day as well as the regular garbage collection day. He informed that household items can be placed at the curb the night before and that there should be no more than five large items and no item should weigh over 50 pounds. Mr. Brizzolara reminded that White Goods are also picked up on Fridays, but the homeowner must contact the Borough Clerk's Office no later than Noon on Thursday to arrange for pick-up. He described a white good as any all-metal item excluding car parts, i.e. washing machines, dryers, stoves, hot water heaters.

Mr. Brizzolara invited the public to visit Bergen County Utilities Authority's web site at www.bcua.org for the dates of their 2007 Household Hazardous Waste Collections. Mr. Brizzolara announced that the next day is Sunday, March 25, 2007 at Bergen Community College, 400 Paramus Road, Paramus from 9 AM to 3 PM. Some materials acceptable for BCUA collections are anti-freeze, bug sprays, fertilizers, gasoline insecticides, pesticides, propane gas cylinders.

Mr. Brizzolara announced that the Borough would be receiving \$3,265.26 from the Bergen County Utilities Authority Municipal Recycling Assistance Program for 2007. These funds can be used to offset the Borough's cost for curbside collection of recyclables, leaves and grass, the printing and mailing of the Borough's newsletter and the purchase of trash bags and containers for all municipal buildings and fields.

Historic Preservation Committee: Mr. Brizzolara reported that the Borough Construction Code Official has contacted the homeowner who constructed a pond encroaching on the cemetery to remove it and that the Council has authorized the Borough Attorney, Mr. Fede to take the necessary steps for the Borough to acquire the property.

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Councilman Knigin: In the absence of Mr. Knigin no reports were given.

Council President Scott:

Property/Zoning: Mr. Scott advised that the homeowner whose pond is encroaching on the cemetery have been put on notice to remove the pond.

Environmental Commission: The Commission has submitted plans for the trails in Central Woods and a proposal for signs and benches. The Commission would also like to make application for an ANJEC Grant for \$20,000 for Fox Hill.

Councilman Guercio:

Board of Health: Mr. Guercio announced that the meeting was cancelled.

DPW: Mr. Guercio informed that the new pick-up truck with snowplow was delivered to the department and is ready to be put in service.

Councilwoman Senatore:

Police: Ms. Senatore read the Police Department's Monthly report, Attachment "A". Mrs. Senatore asked those members of the public who have unregistered phone numbers to contact the Police Department and give them their number. The new Swift Reach Program, which is a reverse 911 used to inform and alert residents can only reach those homes with registered phone numbers. Mrs. Senatore also informed that the Chief will be using Swift Reach to monitor shut-ins. Residents are encouraged to contact the Chief regarding this program. Mrs. Senatore reviewed the DARE program for 5th and 8th graders and the many grants that the Police Department receives and the programs that the grants fund. Mrs. Senatore reported that traffic is flowing more smoothly on Summit Street since the Chief instituted the new parking regulations. Mrs. Senatore commended Chief Krapels for his hard work and dedication. Mr. Brizzolara questioned Mrs. Senatore regarding the report the Council received regarding the speeding on Summit Street. Mr. Brizzolara wanted to know if the Chief could review the raw data from the report generated from the Message Board and break down the times and speeds better for the Council to understand

Councilman Condoleo:

Finance: Mr. Condoleo informed that the Finance Committee has held two meetings so far regarding the 2007 Municipal Budget and they are in the process of comparing the actual expenditures to the amounts requested by the departments. Mr. Condoleo announced that the State has granted an extension to the date set for introduction of the budget to March 11th.

Recreation: The next meeting of the Committee will be on March 5, 2007.

Fire Department: Mr. Condoleo read the Fire Department Monthly Report for January, Attachment "B". Mr. Condoleo informed that the Mayor and Council attended the Fire Department's Installation Dinner in January that was proceeded with an inspection of the Fire House. The new fire truck has been delivered and will go into service once it has been fully equipped.

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General Public Comment:

It was moved by Mr. Brizzolara and seconded by Mr. Guercio to open the meeting to the public for comment. All Council Members present voted for the motion.

Mr. Mitch Rosenthal, 50 Adams Street asked the Council to consider sending out a newsletter to keep the residents informed regarding various information. Mayor Barsa said that he is working on a quarterly newsletter.

Mr. Rosenthal also wanted to know if the re-valuation would affect this year's budget. Mayor Barsa informed that the revaluation will be completed by the end of 2007, but will not be implemented until 2008.

Mr. Bill McGuire, Summit Street handed the Mayor a letter from Elaine Pontone, President, Rockleigh Community Group requesting permission for the owners of Windows, Walls and More located at 100 Oak Street to hold a sale of their excess inventory with all proceeds to be donated to the Rockleigh Volunteer Fire Department and the Alpine Home and School Association. Mayor Barsa said he would review the letter and discuss it at the next work session.

No other member of the public wishing to be heard, a motion to close the meeting to the public was made by Mr. Scott, seconded by Ms. Senatore and declared carried upon the affirmative vote of all Council Members present.


Executive Session:




