Ordinance No. 08:02

**An Ordinance Amending Chapter 168 of the Code of
the Borough of Norwood Regarding the Recreation Committee
Membership and Permitting Process for Special Events**

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to update the provisions in the Code of the Borough of Norwood establishing the membership in the recreation committee and governing the issuance of permits for special events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: Section 168-1(B) of Chapter 168 of the Code of the Borough of Norwood is amended to state the following:

B. The recreation committee of the Borough of Norwood shall consist of eleven (11) members as follows: five (5) at large members and one (1) member representing each of the following six (6) recreation activities:

Knickerbocker Boys Baseball	Grades 7-10
Recreation Football	Grades 1-8
Recreation Basketball	Boys and Girls Grades 1-8
Girls Cheerleading	Grades 1-8
Recreation Baseball/Softball	Boys Grades K-6/Girls Grades K-8
Recreation Soccer	Boys and Girls Grades K-8

Section 2: Section 168-10(B) of the Code is amended to state:

B. Permits shall be issued by the Director of Recreation, after submission to and approval by the Mayor and Council, based upon the following criteria, and permits may contain special conditions as appropriate:

[Subsections 1 to 4 are unchanged]

Section 3: Section 168-11 of the Code, which governs appeals to the Mayor and Council from permits denied or rejected by the Recreation Director, shall be deleted.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of any inconsistencies.

Section 5: The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining parts of this ordinance will remain in full force and effect.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect upon final approval and publication, according to law.
