ORDINANCE NO. 08:06

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED
“AN ORDINANCE TO FIX SALARIES, WAGES, AND COMPENSATION
OF CERTAIN OFFICIALS, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE
BOROUGH OF NORWOOD, COUNTY OF BERGEN, AND STATE OF NEW
JERSEY” AND SETTING FORTH THE METHOD OF PAYING SALARIES AND
ANY OTHER ORDINANCES AMENDING SAID ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to amend ordinance 07:03 to fix the salary and compensation for the new position of employment of Assistant Chief Financial Officer/Deputy Tax Collector/Deputy Treasurer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Norwood, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: The annual salary rate of the Assistant Chief Financial Officer/Deputy Tax Collector/Deputy Treasurer shall be \$52,500, to be paid in bi-weekly installments.

Section 2: All of the other provisions of ordinance 07:30 remain in effect. All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of any inconsistencies.

Section 3: The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, the remaining parts of this ordinance will remain in full force and effect.


Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law, and shall be effective as of the effective date of ordinance 07:30, except that any portion of the ordinance that provides an increase in the salaries, wages, or compensation of elected officials or managerial, executive, or confidential employees shall become operative 20 days after publication, as per N.J.S.A. 40A:9-165.


