Ordinance No. 12:07

**An Ordinance Amending Chapter 202 of the Code of the
Borough of Norwood Regarding Streets and Sidewalks**

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to better regulate the snow removal activities of property owners and occupants, to advance the public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: A new Section 202-5 of Chapter 202 of the Code of the Borough of Norwood is added to state the following:

Section 202-5. Removal of Snow onto Sidewalks, Streets, and Rights-Of-Way Prohibited

Property owners, tenants, other occupants, and all of their agents are prohibited from depositing, placing, or moving snow that was removed from their property onto any public street, road, avenue, highway, sidewalk, or other public right-of-way. All snow cleared on private property must be contained within that property. Snow removed from a sidewalk located in the public right-of-way contiguous to the subject property may be deposited within the boundaries of the right of way, but only without blocking passage on any street, road, or sidewalk.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of any inconsistencies.

Section 3: The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining parts of this ordinance will remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: This ordinance will take effect upon final approval and publication, according to law.
